Getting Ready for the New Session



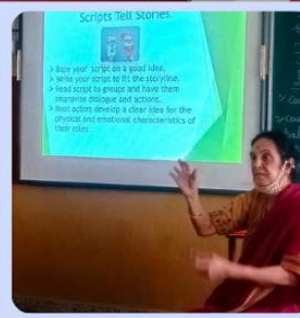
On 16th May, the orientation programme was conducted at Carmel Convent School. The programme started with a warm welcome.
